The NHS App gives you a simple and secure way to access a range of NHS services. Download the NHS App on your smartphone or tablet via the Google Play or App Store. You can also access the same services via a web browser by logging in through the NHS website. You must be aged 13 or over to use the NHS App.





If you live or work in Sefton, our service can offer you and individual quit programme for up to 12 weeks.

You will be offered weekly tailored advice and support from a Specialist Practitioner to help plan and manage your quit attempt.

We are a vape/e-cigarette friendly service and can offer a choice of stop smoking medications including Champix* and Nicotine Replacement Therapy.
